

(c)-(2)-(i) After deducting the cost of any refunds and the prorated share of the cost of operating the Income Tax Division, the Comptroller shall pay over the balance to the appropriate local fiscal authority. All such payments shall be made by the Comptroller as soon as practicable.

(ii) [For fiscal year 1988 only, due] DUE to the uncertainties of the revenue effect of the various provisions of the Tax Reform Act of 1986, FOR FISCAL YEARS 1988 THROUGH 1990, in addition to the amounts provided for in subparagraph (i) of this paragraph, the Comptroller shall pay over the following amounts to the appropriate local fiscal authority of selected counties and Baltimore City:

The payments of the additional amounts provided for in this subparagraph shall be made on or about June 1, 1988 OF THE FISCAL YEAR FOR WHICH THE PAYMENT IS MADE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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(C) FOR FISCAL YEARS 1988 THROUGH 1990 YEAR 1989, IN ADDITION TO THE DISTRIBUTION REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION, THE COMPTROLLER SHALL PAY THE FOLLOWING AMOUNTS TO SELECTED COUNTIES:
