(House Bill 640)

AN ACT concerning

Law Enforcement and-Correctional-Praining-Fund, Correctional, and Police Officers

FOR the purpose of exempting from the certification requirements the Police Training Commission nonfull-time police officers employed by certain law enforcement units; defining a certain term; providing for the effective date of this establishing a Law Enforcement and Correctional Training Fund to be law enforcement and used for correctional training; increasing certain court clarifying the charging of certain court costs; designating a revenue source for the fund, -with-certain--exceptions--and under--certain--conditions;--providing-for-the-collection-of revenues;-establishing-a-Board-of-Trustees-to-administer-the fund;-providing-for-the-appointment-of-Board-members-and-the Board-Chairman; fund; requiring the State Comptroller to establish and maintain a certain account; setting-forth restrictions--on--a-certain--account; --providing--for---the promulgation--of--rules-and-regulations;-requiring-the-Board of-Trustees-to-report-certain-information-to-the--Governor and---General---Assembly; providing for the accounting, investing and budgeting of the Fund in a certain manner; establishing a certain date for the withdrawal of funds; and generally relating to the employment of police officers and the Law Enforcement and Correctional Training Fund.
