- (3) IN A JUDICIAL PROCEEDING AUTHORIZED BY THIS SECTION, THE SOLE ISSUES SHALL BE WHETHER THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS ACTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH:
- (1) PROCEDURES CONCERNING COUNTY ORDINANCES IN ARTICLE 25, § 3(R) OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND;
 - (II) THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION; OR
 - (III) OTHER PROCEDURES REQUIRED BY LAW.
- (4) ISSUES SUBJECT TO REVIEW UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE DECIDED BY THE COURT WITHOUT A JURY.
- (5) THE COUNTY MAY APPEAL A DECISION OF THE CIRCUIT COURT UNDER THIS SECTION TO THE COURT OF SPECIAL APPEALS.
- [D.] E. If the County Commissioners condemn any necessary land for the use of roads, the procedures outlines in the Annotated Code, Real Property Article, Title 12, and applicable sections of Article 89B are to be followed.
