of the regulation reverts to its status before the emergency adoption.

(5) The Committee may rescind its approval by a majority of its members present and voting at a public hearing $\overline{\text{OR}}$ MEETING OF THE COMMITTEE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1988.

CHAPTER 479

(House Bill 940)

AN ACT concerning

Progress Unlimited, Inc. Loan of 1986

FOR the purpose of amending Chapter 508 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1986 (The Progress Unlimited, Inc. Loan of 1986) to extend the time for Progress Unlimited, Inc. to provide certain satisfactory evidence that it will provide a certain matching fund to the Board of Public Works.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Chapter 508 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1986 Section 1

Preamble

WHEREAS, In 1986 the General Assembly enacted Chapter 508 know as the Progress Unlimited, Inc. Loan of 1986; and

WHEREAS, The proceeds of this loan provided for in the Act were dedicated to assist in the construction of a day/vocational training program for mentally retarded persons in Baltimore. County; and

WHEREAS, Progress Unlimited, Inc. is committed to providing an equal and matching fund as specified under Chapter 508 of 1986; and

WHEREAS, Since the enactment of the legislation, the Maryland Developmental Disabilities Administration has introduced
