- (A) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PREPARE A COMPREHENSIVE MANAGEMENT PLAN FOR THE HARVESTING OF:
 - (1) STRIPED BASS OR ROCKFISH; AND
 - (2) WHITE PERCH; AND
 - (2) (3) YELLOW PERCH.
- (B) THE COMPREHENSIVE MANAGEMENT PLAN UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL INCLUDE:
 - (1) SUSTAINABLE HARVEST RATES; AND
- (2) INDICATORS THAT WOULD TRIGGER ANY TIGHTENING OR LOOSENING OF HARVEST RESTRICTIONS.
- (C) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PRESENT THE COMPREHENSIVE MANAGEMENT PLAN UNDER THIS SECTION IN THE FORM OF A REPORT TO:
 - (1) THE LEGISLATIVE POLICY COMMITTEE;
- (2) THE ECONOMIC AND ENVIRONMENTAL AFFAIRS COMMITTEE;
 - (3) THE ENVIRONMENTAL MATTERS COMMITTEE.
- (D) ON OR BEFORE JANUARY 30, 1989, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PRESENT TO THE COMMITTEES OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY LISTED UNDER SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION:
- (1) A REPORT ON THE STATUS OF THE COMPREHENSIVE MANAGEMENT PLAN, INCLUDING PROPOSED ELEMENTS OF THE PLAN AND A PROPOSED SCHEDULE OF ITS IMPLEMENTATION;
- (2) A DETAILED EXPLANATION OF THE SCIENTIFIC AND OTHER INFORMATION ON WHICH THE PLAN IS BASED; AND
- (3) ANY NECESSARY RECOMMENDATIONS ON LEGISLATION, REGULATORY CHANGE, OR REGULATION THAT THE PLAN PROVIDES.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1988.
