LAWS OF MARYLAND

- (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION, "COIN OPERATED GAME" MEANS AN AMUSEMENT DEVICE THAT IS OPERATED OR ACTIVATED BY COINS OR TOKENS.
 - (2) "COIN OPERATED GAME" INCLUDES:
 - (I) A BOWLING MACHINE:
 - (II) AN ELECTRONIC GAME;
 - (III) A PINBALL MACHINE;
 - (IV) A VIDEO GAME; OR
 - (V) OTHER SIMILAR DEVICE.
 - (3) "COIN OPERATED GAME" DOES NOT INCLUDE:
 - (I) A MACHINE THAT PAYS OUT COINS OR TOKENS; OR
- (II) A BONA FIDE VENDING MACHINE THAT DOES NOT INCLUDE AMUSEMENT FEATURES.
- (B) AFTER A PUBLIC HEARING, THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MAY ADOPT ORDINANCES OR REGULATIONS CONCERNING:
 - (1) COIN OPERATED GAME LICENSING;
 - (2) LICENSE FEE SETTING:
 - (3) LICENSE ISSUING PROCEDURES:
 - (4) LICENSE APPLICATION PROCEDURES:
 - (5) LICENSE DISPLAY REQUIREMENTS;
 - (6) LATE FEE RENEWAL PROVISIONS:
 - (7) PRORATED FEE SCHEDULES; AND
- (8) OTHER ADMINISTRATIVE PROVISIONS AS DETERMINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS.
- (C) (1) BEFORE KEEPING, MAINTAINING, OR OPERATING A COIN-OPERATED GAME FOR PUBLIC ENTERTAINMENT IN CARROLL COUNTY, A PERSON, CORPORATION, OR OTHER ENTITY SHALL OBTAIN THE APPROPRIATE LICENSE FROM THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.
- (2) A LICENSE ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION EXPIRES ON APRIL 30 IN EACH YEAR, REGARDLESS OF DATE OF ISSUANCE.
- (3) A LICENSE ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION IS TRANSFERABLE.
