~~(i) ESTABLISH THE MINIMUM AGE OF A CHILD CARE WORKER; AND~~

~~(ii) PROVIDE FOR THE COMPOSITION AND DUTIES OF THE TREATMENT TEAM.~~

(2) THE SECRETARY OF HUMAN RESOURCES AND THE DIRECTOR OF THE JUVENILE SERVICES AGENCY SHALL JOINTLY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO ENSURE THAT ANY CHILD PLACED IN SHELTER CARE PURSUANT TO A PETITION FILED UNDER SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION BE PROVIDED APPROPRIATE SERVICES, INCLUDING:

(I) HEALTH CARE SERVICES;

(II) COUNSELING SERVICES;

(III) EDUCATION SERVICES; AND

(IV) SOCIAL WORK SERVICES.

(3) IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER PROVISION, THE REGULATIONS SHALL REQUIRE:

(I) THE LOCAL DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES OR THE JUVENILE SERVICES AGENCY TO DEVELOP A PLAN WITHIN 45 DAYS OF PLACEMENT OF A CHILD IN A SHELTER CARE FACILITY TO ASSESS THE CHILD'S TREATMENT NEEDS; AND

(II) THE PLAN TO BE SUBMITTED TO ALL PARTIES TO THE PETITION AND THEIR COUNSEL.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1988.

AN ACT concerning
