- (a) The Trust shall meet at [the call of its Chairman or of a majority of its members] LEAST TWICE A YEAR OR AS NECESSARY AS DETERMINED BY THE TRUST.
 - (b) A VOTING AND NONVOTING member of the Trust:
 - (1) may not receive compensation; but
- (2) is entitled to reimbursement for expenses under the Standard State Travel Regulations, as provided in the State budget.
 - (C) THE TRUST MAY:
- (1) ADOPT BYLAWS FOR THE REGULATION OF ITS AFFAIRS AND THE CONDUCT OF ITS BUSINESS; AND
- (2) APPOINT COMMITTEES TO CARRY OUT THE PURPOSES OF THE TRUST.
