(House Bill 1202)

AN ACT concerning

Baltimore County - Alcoholic Beverages Inspectors

FOR the purpose of authorizing the alcoholic beverages license inspectors and the Chief License Inspector in Baltimore County to request and examine certain evidence used as proof age for the purpose of purchasing alcoholic beverages; requiring that the request and examination be made on on or licensed the premises within--the--inspector's jurisdiction in Baltimore County.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- The several boards of license commissioners herewith authorized and empowered to issue the alcoholic beverages licenses provided for by this article in their respective jurisdictions.
- (b) The respective board shall be authorized to employ secretary and such inspectors, clerical and other assistance as may be necessary, and to fix the compensation of such employees, except as otherwise provided by this article.
