- (B) (A) THE PURPOSE OF THE WESTERN MARYLAND REGIONAL TOURISM BUREAU IS TO:
- (1) DEVELOP REGIONAL ADVERTISING AND MARKETING PROGRAMS TO DISSEMINATE INFORMATION ABOUT WESTERN MARYLAND;
- (2) STIMULATE THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE TOURIST BUSINESS IN WESTERN MARYLAND;
- (3) ENCOURAGE THE DEVELOPMENT OF WESTERN MARYLAND'S RECREATIONAL AREAS AND FACILITIES;
- (4) PROMOTE WESTERN MARYLAND'S BUSINESS AND JOB OPPORTUNITIES THROUGH TOURISM;
- (5) DEVELOP PUBLIC AWARENESS OF WESTERN MARYLAND'S HERITAGE AND HISTORY;
- (6) COORDINATE AND FACILITATE SPECIAL EVENTS PROGRAMMING FOR WESTERN MARYLAND;
- (7) SERVE AS A LIAISON BETWEEN THE WESTERN MARYLAND TOURISM INDUSTRY, THE GOVERNOR, THE DEPARTMENT, OTHER STATE AGENCIES, PRIVATE ORGANIZATIONS, AND THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY; AND
- (8) ADVISE THE GOVERNOR, THE DEPARTMENT, AND THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY ON PROGRAMS AFFECTING THE TOURISM INDUSTRY.
- (e) (b) (1) THE EXECUTIVE BOARD OF THE BUREAU CONSISTS OF 15 MEMBERS.
 - (2) OF THE 15 COUNCIL MEMBERS:
 - (I) 5 MEMBERS SHALL BE FROM GARRETT COUNTY;
 - (II) 5 MEMBERS SHALL BE FROM ALLEGANY COUNTY;

AND

- (III) 5 MEMBERS SHALL BE FROM WASHINGTON COUNTY.
- (C) OF THE 5 EXECUTIVE BOARD MEMBERS IN ALLEGANY COUNTY AND WASHINGTON COUNTY:
- (1) 2 MEMBERS SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS;
