QUALIFIED IN THE ACCOUNTING AND AUDITING OF PUBLIC BODIES. THE OF AUDIT SHALL BE PREPARED IN ACCORDANCE WITH GENERALLY ACCEPTED AUDITING PRINCIPLES AND POINT OUT ANY IRREGULARITIES FOUND TO EXIST. THE AUDITORS SHALL REPORT TO THE SECRETARY THE RESULTS OF THEIR EXAMINATION, INCLUDING THEIR UNQUALIFIED OPINION ON THE PRESENTATION OF THE FINANCIAL POSITION OF THE FUND AND THE RESULTS OF THE ADMINISTRATION'S FINANCIAL OPERATIONS. ΙF ARE UNABLE TO EXPRESS AN UNQUALIFIED OPINION THEY SHALL STATE AND EXPLAIN DETAIL THE IN REASONS FOR THEIR QUALIFICATIONS, DISCLAIMER, OR OPINION INCLUDING RECOMMENDATIONS NECESSARY MAKE POSSIBLE FUTURE UNQUALIFIED OPINIONS.

- (B)--THE-BOOKS,-RECORDS,-AND-ACCOUNTS-OF-THE-ADMINISTRATION ARE-SUBJECT-TO-AUDIT-BY-THE-STATE;--ANY-OFFICER-OR-EMPLOYEE-WHO REFUSES-TO-GIVE-THE-REQUIRED-ASSISTANCE-AND-INFORMATION-TO-THE ACCOUNTANTS-SELECTED-BY-THE-ADMINISTRATION-OR-BY-THE-STATE-OR-WHO REFUSES-TO-SUBMIT-TO-THEM-FOR-EXAMINATION-THE-BOOKS,--DOCUMENTS, RECORDS,--FILES,--ACCOUNTS,--PAPERS,-THINGS,-OR-PROPERTY-REQUIRED FOR-THE-AUDIT,--IN-THE-DISCRETION-OF-THE-SECRETARY,--MAY-BE REQUIRED-TO-FORFEIT-HIS-OR-HER-OFFICE-OR-EMPLOYMENT.
- (B) (1) THE SECRETARY SHALL REPORT ON OR BEFORE JANUARY 15 OF EACH YEAR TO THE GOVERNOR AND, SUBJECT TO § 2-1312 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY ON THE STATUS OF THE FUND.

(2) THE SECRETARY'S REPORT SHALL INCLUDE:

- (I) THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF FUNDS EXPENDED;
- (II) THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF FUNDS COMMITTED;
- (III) THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF FUNDS REMAINING:
- BEEN EXPENDED OR ARE COMMITTED;
- (V) A PROJECTION OF PROJECTS TO BE CONSTRUCTED IN THE NEAR FUTURE FOR WHICH LOANS OR LOAN GUARANTEES WILL BE MADE;
- (VI) AN EVALUATION OF THE PROGRAM'S EFFECTIVENESS; AND
- (VII) PROJECTIONS AS TO FUTURE FUNDING REQUIREMENTS.

THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL CONTINUE UNTIL TERMINATED BY THAT NO SUCH LAW SHALL TAKE EFFECT SO LONG AS THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL OUTSTANDING, HAVE BONDS UNLESS ADEQUATE PROVISION HAS BEEN MADE FOR THE PAYMENT THEREOF.
