Provide a portion of the funds to construct (5) and purchase capital equipment for a 720-bed medium security correctional institution at Maryland Correctional Institution -Hagerstown Complex (Washington County), provided that the perimeter security at all State Correctional facilities in Washington County shall be at least equivalent to perimeter security of a State medium security correctional institution. THE AMOUNT OF FUNDS IN THIS APPROPRIATION NOT ENCUMBERED FOR THE PURPOSES IDENTIFIED ABOVE AS OF JUNE 1, 1988 SHALL BE USED TO ALTER, EXPAND AND EQUIP THE CENTRAL WAREHOUSE BUILDING AT THE HAGERSTOWN CORRECTIONAL COMPLEX FOR USE AS A CENTRAL KITCHEN, AND MODIFY AND EQUIP EXISTING KITCHENS AT THE COMPLEX.
