- (D) (1) AN APPOINTING AUTHORITY MAY REQUEST CERTIFICATION AN ELIGIBLE WITH SPECIFIC JOB-RELATED QUALIFICATIONS OR FOR A SPECIFIC GEOGRAPHIC AREA. THE APPOINTING AUTHORITY'S REQUEST FOR SELECTIVE CERTIFICATION SHALL INCLUDE THE REASONS FOR SELECTIVE CERTIFICATION, INCLUDING THE DUTIES OF THE POSITION THAT REQUIRE SPECIFIC JOB-RELATED QUALIFICATIONS. THE REQUEST MAY BE APPROVED OR DENIED BY THE SECRETARY. IF THE SECRETARY APPROVES A REQUEST FOR SELECTIVE CERTIFICATION, THE CERTIFICATION MAY LIMITED PERSONS WHO MEET THOSE SPECIFIC JOB-RELATED QUALIFICATIONS OR WHO HAVE INDICATED AVAILABILITY FOR SPECIFIED GEOGRAPHIC AREA FOR THAT PARTICULAR POSITION.
- (2) THE APPOINTING AUTHORITY SHALL TRANSMIT TO THE SECRETARY WITH THE REQUEST FOR SELECTIVE CERTIFICATION A STATEMENT CERTIFYING THAT THE REQUEST IS NOT SUBMITTED ON THE BASIS OF RACE, COLOR, POLITICAL AFFILIATION, RELIGION, CREED, NATIONAL ORIGIN, ANCESTRY, MARITAL STATUS, OR SEX.

- (e) Promotion is a change from one class to another class with a higher maximum compensation, and vacancies shall be filled by promotion as far as is consistent with the best interests of the classified service, in the judgment of the Secretary. [Unclassified employees shall have the same right as classified employees to take promotional examinations for positions in the classified service, providing they have the necessary qualifications; and shall also have the right to be temporarily appointed to such positions, when qualified, under the provisions of § 24(a) of this Article.]
