Chapter 504 of the Acts of 1986

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect January 1, 1987. [The changes made to Article 64A, § 37(a)(1) of the Code as enacted by Section 1 of this Act shall remain effective for a period of 2 years and, at the end of December 31, 1988, and with no further action required by the General Assembly, the changes made to Article 64A, § 37(a)(1) of the Code under this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.]

SECTION $4 \div 3$. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section(s) 27(g) of Article 64A - Merit System of the Annotated Code of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 27(e).
