4-210. ANNUAL REPORTS.

(A) IN GENERAL.

THE COMMISSION SHALL PREPARE AN ANNUAL REPORT OF ITS ACTIVITIES THAT INCLUDES:

- (1) A STATEMENT OF THE TOTAL RECEIPTS FROM LICENSE FEES;
- (2) A STATEMENT OF THE TOTAL EXPENDITURES OF THE COMMISSION;
- (3) THE NUMBER OF REAL ESTATE BROKER LICENSES, ASSOCIATE REAL ESTATE BROKER LICENSES, AND REAL ESTATE SALESPERSON LICENSES ISSUED IN EACH COUNTY;
- (4) THE NUMBER OF HEARINGS HELD;
- (5) THE NUMBER OF COMPLAINTS RECEIVED;
- (6) THE NUMBER OF INVESTIGATIONS MADE;
- (7) THE NUMBER OF APPLICATIONS FOR LICENSES DENIED;
- (8) THE TOTAL NUMBER OF LICENSES SUSPENDED OR REVOKED; AND
- (9) ANY OTHER INFORMATION THAT REFLECTS THE WORK OF THE COMMISSION.

(B) SUBMISSION TO SECRETARY; INCLUSION IN ANNUAL REPORT.

- (1) THE COMMISSION SHALL SUBMIT THE ANNUAL REPORT TO THE SECRETARY.
- (2) THE SECRETARY SHALL INCLUDE THE ANNUAL REPORT SUBMITTED EACH YEAR UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION IN THE ANNUAL REPORT OF THE SECRETARY.
