4-306. EXAMINATIONS.

(A) RIGHT TO EXAMINATION.

AN APPLICANT WHO OTHERWISE QUALIFIES FOR A LICENSE IS ENTITLED TO BE EXAMINED AS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION.

(B) TIME AND PLACE OF EXAMINATION.

THE COMMISSION PERIODICALLY SHALL GIVE EXAMINATIONS TO APPLICANTS AT THE TIMES AND PLACES THAT THE COMMISSION DETERMINES.

(C) NOTICE OF EXAMINATION.

EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (F)(2)(II) OF THIS SECTION, THE COMMISSION SHALL GIVE EACH QUALIFIED APPLICANT NOTICE OF THE TIME AND PLACE OF EXAMINATION.

(D) EXAMINATION FEE.

TO TAKE AN EXAMINATION, AN APPLICANT SHALL PAY:

- (1) TO THE COMMISSION, AN A \$10 EXAMINATION FEE OF:

~~{i}--\$5---FOR---A---REAL---ESTATE---SALESPERSON EXAMINATION;--OR~~

~~{ii}--\$10--FOR-A-REAL-ESTATE-BROKER-EXAMINATION;~~
AND

- (2) TO THE COMMISSION OR A TESTING SERVICE CHOSEN BY THE COMMISSION, AN AMOUNT COVERING THE COST OF THE EXAMINATION.

(E) SUBJECTS AND METHOD OF EXAMINATION.

(1) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SUBSECTION, THE COMMISSION SHALL DETERMINE THE SUBJECTS, SCOPE AND FORM OF, AND THE PASSING SCORE FOR EXAMINATIONS GIVEN UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.

(2) TO ENSURE THE PROTECTION OF THE INTERESTS OF THOSE PERSONS WHO ARE REPRESENTED BY LICENSED REAL ESTATE
