4-315. CONTINUING EDUCATION.

(A) IN GENERAL.

- (1) TO QUALIFY FOR RENEWAL OF A LICENSE UNDER THIS SUBTITLE, A LICENSEE SHALL COMPLETE AT LEAST 12 CLOCK HOURS OF CONTINUING EDUCATION INSTRUCTION, AS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION, DURING EACH 2-YEAR LICENSE TERM.
- (2) NOTWITHSTANDING PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, IF A LICENSE IS GRANTED TO A LICENSEE DURING THE 2ND YEAR OF A LICENSE TERM, THE LICENSEE MAY RENEW THE LICENSE FOR THE NEXT FIII.I. TERM WITHOUT COMPLYING WITH THE CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.

(B) SUBJECT MATTER.

- (1) THE COMMISSION SHALL APPROVE THE FORM, SUBSTANCE, AS PROVIDED UNDER PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, SUBJECT MATTER OF ALL CONTINUING EDUCATION COURSES.
- THE SUBJECT MATTER APPROVED BY THE COMMISSION (2) SHALL RELATE TO REAL ESTATE.
- (3) TO BE ACCEPTABLE FOR CREDIT AS A CONTINUING EDUCATION COURSE UNDER THIS SECTION, THE COURSE SHALL COVER 1 OR MORE TOPICS APPROVED BY THE COMMISSION.

(C) CONDUCTING COURSES.

- (1) CONTINUING EDUCATION COURSES MAY BE CONDUCTED BY:
- (I) THE MARYLAND ASSOCIATION OF REALTORS OR ITS MEMBER BOARDS;
- (II) THE REAL ESTATE BROKERS OF BALTIMORE CITY, INC.:
 - (III) ANY SIMILAR PROFESSIONAL ASSOCIATION; OR
- (IV) AN EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION APPROVED BY THE COMMISSION.
- (2) CONTINUING EDUCATION COURSES SHALL BE TAUGHT BY A QUALIFIED INSTRUCTOR WHO IS EXPERIENCED IN THE REAL ESTATE INDUSTRY.
