

(2) [own] OWNS or [control] CONTROLS and [dedicate] DEDICATES at least 1 million gallons of storage capacity in the State to gasoline, other than aviation gasoline, and to special fuel; and

(3) [keep] KEEPS in the State an inventory of at least 500,000 gallons of that gasoline and special fuel.

(b) To qualify for a Class "B" license, an applicant shall be an entity that:

(1) imports motor fuel for personal use or for redistribution; and

(2) is licensed by the state from which the [motor fuel] GASOLINE is TO BE exported FOR IMPORTATION INTO THIS STATE.

(c) To qualify for a Class "C" license, an applicant shall be an entity that:

(1) is based in another state;

(2) [only exports from this State:

(i) gasoline, other than aviation gasoline; or

(ii) special fuel;

(3) is licensed by the state [from] TO which that gasoline [or special fuel] is TO BE exported;

[(4)] (3) has no sales in this State; and

[(5)] (4) does not own [or], operate OR UTILIZE in this State a facility that can store or dispense [that gasoline or special] MOTOR fuel.

(d) To qualify for a Class "D" license, an applicant shall be an entity that:

(1) is [incorporated] ORGANIZED under the laws of [this] THE State;

(2) [is] DOES not [a producer or refiner] BLEND OR REFINE GASOLINE;

(3) [keeps in the State fixed storage tanks for:

(i) gasoline, other than aviation gasoline; or

(ii) special fuel;
