this loan or any matching funds have been or are being used for a purpose prohibited by this Act.

(7) The College of Notre Dame of Maryland shall grant and convey a perpetual preservation easement on the exterior and interior of the structures, where appropriate, and on the land to the Maryland Historical Trust in form and substance acceptable to the Trust.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1988.
