Annotated Code of Maryland (1982 Replacement Volume and 1987 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments

403A.

- (a) Any person under the age of 18 years who violates the provisions of this subheading shall be issued a citation by a police officer authorized to make arrests and shall be subject to the procedures and dispositions provided in Subtitle 8 of Title 3 of the Courts and Judicial Proceedings Article.
- (b) Any person 18 years old or older who violates the provisions of this subheading shall be issued a citation and be subject to the provisions of § 403B of this subheading.

403B.

- (f) (1) If a person is found by the District Court to have committed a Code violation, that person shall be required to pay a fine in an amount not to exceed [\$100] \$500.
- (2) If the violation is a repeat offense, that person shall be required to pay a fine in an amount not to exceed [\$500] \$1,000.
- (3) The person shall be liable for the costs of the proceedings in the District Court.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1988.
