- (D) (1) "MERCHANT" MEANS A PERSON WHO, DIRECTLY OR OFFERS OR MAKES AVAILABLE TO CONSUMERS ANY CONSUMER INDIRECTLY, GOODS, CONSUMER SERVICES, OR CONSUMER REALTY.
- "MERCHANT" DOES NOT INCLUDE A PERSON WHO IS EXEMPT UNDER § 13-104 OF THIS ARTICLE.
- "TELEPHONE SOLICITATION" MEANS THE ATTEMPT MERCHANT TO SELL OR LEASE CONSUMER GOODS, SERVICES, OR REALTY TO A CONSUMER LOCATED IN THIS STATE THAT IS:
  - (1) MADE ENTIRELY BY TELEPHONE; AND
  - (2) INITIATED BY THE MERCHANT.

## THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ACT DO NOT APPLY TO A TRANSACTION:

- RETAIL BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENT WHICH HAS A FIXED PERMANENT LOCATION AND WHERE CONSUMER GOODS ARE DISPLAYED OR OFFERED FOR SALE ON A CONTINUING BASIS;
- IN WHICH THE PERSON OR--THE--BUSINESS--ENTERPRISE MAKING THE SOLICITATION OR THE BUSINESS ENTERPRISE FOR WHICH THE PERSON IS CALLING:
- (I) HAS MADE A PREVIOUS SALE TO THE CONSUMER; OR
- (II) HAS A PREEXISTING BUSINESS RELATIONSHIP WITH THE CONSUMER;
- (3) WHICH IS COVERED BY THE PROVISIONS OF SUBTITLE 3 OF THIS TITLE;

## (4) IN WHICH:

- THE CONSUMER MAY OBTAIN A FULL REFUND FOR THE RETURN OF UNDAMAGED AND UNUSED GOODS TO THE SELLER WITHIN DAYS OF RECEIPT BY THE CONSUMER; AND
- (II) #N--WHICH THE SELLER WILL PROCESS 30 DAYS OF RECEIPT OF THE RETURNED MERCHANDISE BY REFUND WITHIN THE CONSUMER;
- IN WHICH THE CONSUMER PURCHASES GOODS OR SERVICES PURSUANT TO AN EXAMINATION OF A TELEVISION, RADIO, OR PRINT ADVERTISEMENT OR A SAMPLE, BROCHURE, CATALOGUE, OR OTHER MAILING MATERIAL OF THE MERCHANT WHICH THAT CONTAINS:
