- (A) IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.
- (B) "CONSUMER" MEANS AN ACTUAL OR PROSPECTIVE PURCHASER, LESSEE, OR RECIPIENT OF CONSUMER GOODS, CONSUMER SERVICES, OR CONSUMER REALTY, OR CONSUMER CREDIT.
