- (3) A REASONABLE ATTORNEY'S FEE AND OTHER LITIGATION COSTS REASONABLY INCURRED.
- (C) THE COURT MAY ASSESS AS DAMAGES IN A CIVIL ACTION UNDER SECTION THE SUM OF THE ACTUAL DAMAGES SUFFERED BY THE PLAINTIFF AND ANY PROFITS MADE BY THE VIOLATOR AS A RESULT OF THE VIOLATION, BUT IN NO CASE SHALL A PERSON ENTITLED TO RECOVER RECEIVE LESS THAN \$1,000.
- (D) A GOOD FAITH RELIANCE ON ANY OF THE FOLLOWING IS A COMPLETE DEFENSE TO ANY CIVIL OR CRIMINAL ACTION BROUGHT UNDER THIS SUBTITLE OR ANY OTHER STATE LAW:
- (1) A COURT WARRANT OR ORDER, A GRAND JURY SUBPOENA, A LEGISLATIVE AUTHORIZATION, OR A STATUTORY AUTHORIZATION; OR
- (2) A GOOD FAITH DETERMINATION THAT SECTION 10-402(D) OF THIS TITLE PERMITTED THE CONDUCT THAT IS THE SUBJECT OF THE ACTION.
- A CIVIL ACTION UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE FILED WITHIN 2 YEARS AFTER THE DAY ON WHICH THE CLAIMANT FIRST DISCOVERED OR HAD A REASONABLE OPPORTUNITY TO DISCOVER THE VIOLATION.

- (A) IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.
- (B) "WIRE COMMUNICATION" "ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATION", AND "ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATION SERVICE" HAVE THE MEANINGS STATED IN § 10-401 OF THIS TITLE.
- (C) "COURT OF COMPETENT JURISDICTION" MEANS A CIRCUIT COURT.
- (D) (1) "PEN REGISTER" MEANS A DEVICE THAT RECORDS AND DECODES ELECTRONIC OR OTHER IMPULSES THAT IDENTIFY THE DIALED OR OTHERWISE TRANSMITTED ON THE TELEPHONE LINE TO WHICH THE DEVICE IS ATTACHED.
- (2) "PEN REGISTER" DOES NOT INCLUDE ANY DEVICE USED BY A PROVIDER OR CUSTOMER OF A WIRE OR ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATION SERVICE FOR BILLING, OR RECORDING AS AN INCIDENT TO BILLING, FOR COMMUNICATIONS SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE PROVIDER OR ANY DEVICE
