CHAPTER 616

(Senate Bill 768)

AN ACT concerning

Creation of a State Debt - Upper-Bay-Fisheries-Research-Center
Northern Chesapeake Bay Research and Monitoring Facility

FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of ~~\$250,000~~ \$200,000, the proceeds to be used as ~~a--grant--to~~ by the University of Maryland Center for Environmental and Estuarine Studies, and-to--the--Department of Natural Resources in consultation with the Department of Natural Resources and the Department of the Environment for the planning, development and acquisition of a research site and upper siting, design, and construction of the Northern Chesapeake Bay fisheries management research plans Research and Monitoring Facility in Harford County; and proving generally for the issue and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That:

(1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Upper-Bay-Fisheries-Research-Center Northern Chesapeake Bay Research and Monitoring Facility Loan of 1988 in the total principal amount of ~~\$250,000~~ \$200,000. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale, and delivery of State general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and issued, sold, and delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117 through 8-124 of the State Finance and Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.

(2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as a single issue, or may be consolidated and
