CHAPTER 640

(House Bill 226)

AN ACT concerning

Transportation-- Leases of State-owned Property

FOR the purpose of authorizing the State Highway Administration to execute certain leases of State-owned property; requiring that whenever any unit of the State government leases any State-owned property, the lease shall include a certain prohibition; providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to the leasing of State-owned property.
