

Annotated Code of Maryland
(As enacted by Chapter _____ (S.B. 1) of the
Acts of the General Assembly of 1988)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article --- Estates and Trusts

2-206.

(a) -- The registers of wills are entitled to charge and collect for the performance of their duties the fees in this section.

{(b)} -- For taking probate of wills, entering the names, necessary oaths including and granting letters testamentary, taking, filing, and recording bond, issuing warrant to appraisers and administering the necessary oaths to the person or persons to whom letters may be granted, including seals to letters and warrants to appraise.....\$10.00}

{(c)} -- For entering on the estate docket, papers filed in an estate so that the docket will show a complete list of incidents connected with the administration of each estate.....\$3.50}

{(d)} -- For filing an election of a surviving spouse to take an intestate share and for filing renunciations of heirs or legatees, personal representatives, guardians, trustees.....\$1.00}

{B}-(1) -- FOR TAKING PROBATE OF WILLS AND FURNISHING 2 CERTIFIED COPIES OF THE WILL AND CODICILS, GRANTING LETTERS OF ADMINISTRATION AND FURNISHING 12 CERTIFICATES OF LETTERS, ISSUING WARRANTS TO APPRAISE, ENTERING ON ESTATE DOCKET, FILING ELECTIONS OF SURVIVING SPOUSES TO TAKE INTESTATE SHARES, FILING RENUNCIATIONS AND DISCLAIMERS, FILING AND RECORDING WILLS, BONDS, INVENTORIES, ACCOUNTS OF SALE, RELEASES, ADMINISTRATION ACCOUNTS, PETITIONS AND ORDERS, AND OTHER PAPERS FILED IN THE ADMINISTRATION OF DECEDENTS' ESTATES NOT OTHERWISE SPECIFIED IN SUBSECTIONS (c) THROUGH (f) OF THIS SECTION, THE PROBATE FEES UNDER PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION.

{2} -- PROBATE FEES SHALL BE ASSESSED ON THE VALUE OF THE PROBATE ESTATE AT THE FOLLOWING RATES:
