

(1) 33% to the Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation Fund for the purposes specified in Title 2, Subtitle 5 of the Agriculture Article; and

(2) 67% to the General Fund of the State.

{2-1503.}-2-1403.

After making the distributions required under §§ {2-1501 and 2-1502} 2-1401 AND 2-1402 of this subtitle, the Comptroller shall distribute 3/13 of the remaining tobacco tax revenue to the General Fund of the State.

{2-1504.}-2-1404.

After making the distributions required under §§ {2-1501 through 2-1503} 2-1401 THROUGH 2-1403 of this subtitle, the Comptroller shall distribute the amount necessary to administer the tobacco tax laws to an administrative cost account.

{2-1505.}-2-1405.

After making the distributions required under §§ {2-1501 through 2-1504} 2-1401 THROUGH 2-1404 of this subtitle, the Comptroller shall distribute 70% of the remaining tobacco tax revenue to the General Fund of the State.

{2-1506.}-2-1406.

After making the distributions required under §§ {2-1501 through 2-1505} 2-1401 THROUGH 2-1405 of this subtitle, from the remaining tobacco tax revenue, the Comptroller shall distribute each quarter to a county the amount that, based on the most recent, applicable population records of the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, equals:

(1) for a county that imposed and collected a cigarette tax in 1960, the greater of:

(i) the net amount of cigarette tax that the county collected in 1960, after subtracting its administrative and collection expenses in 1960; or

(ii) a fraction of the remaining tobacco tax revenue:

1. the numerator of which is the population of the county; and

2. the denominator of which is the population of the State; and
