LAWS OF MARYLAND

EMPLOY ANY INDIVIDUAL, THE EMPLOYER SHALL FILE WITH THE ISSUING AUTHORITY:

- (1) A CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE WITH THE STATE WORKERS' COMPENSATION LAWS; OR
- (2) THE NUMBER OF A WORKERS' COMPENSATION INSURANCE POLICY OR BINDER.

COMMITTEE COMMENT: This section is new language that repeats the provisions of present Art. 56, § 2C.

It states a requirement established by Art. 101, § 31A of the Code and also is based on Art. 41, § 1-402 of the Code.

In this section, the word "[w]orkers'" is substituted for the former word "[w]orkmen's", to conform to Art. 101, § 14A of the Code.

3-101. DEFINITIONS.

(A) IN GENERAL.

IN THIS TITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(B) APPRENTICE PLUMBER.

"APPRENTICE PLUMBER" MEANS, UNLESS THE CONTEXT REQUIRES OTHERWISE, AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS LICENSED BY THE BOARD TO ASSIST A MASTER PLUMBER OR A HOLDER OF A LIMITED MASTER PLUMBER LICENSE IN PROVIDING PLUMBING SERVICES WHILE:

- (1) UNDER THE DIRECTION AND CONTROL OF THE MASTER PLUMBER OR HOLDER OF THE LIMITED MASTER PLUMBER LICENSE; AND
 - (2) IN TRAINING TO BECOME A JOURNEY PLUMBER.
 - COMMITTEE COMMENT: This subsection is new language added to provide an express definition of "apprentice plumber".
