## 3-206. ENFORCEMENT OF PLUMBING CODES.

(A) REQUIRED; LOCAL CODES ALLOWED.

## A COUNTY SHALL:

- (1) ENFORCE THE STATE PLUMBING CODE; OR
- (2) ADOPT AND ENFORCE A LOCAL PLUMBING CODE THAT MEETS OR EXCEEDS THE MINIMUM STANDARDS OF THE STATE PLUMBING CODE FOR THE PROPER DESIGN, ACCEPTABLE INSTALLATION, AND ADEQUATE MAINTENANCE OF PLUMBING SYSTEMS.
  - (B) ENFORCEMENT BY BOARD.
- - (2) (C) COOPERATIVE AGREEMENTS.

THE BOARD MAY MAKE A COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT WITH A COUNTY FOR THE COUNTY TO ENFORCE:

(1) THE STATE PLUMBING CODE; OR

 $\{\pm\pm\}(2)$  IF THE COUNTY HAS ADOPTED A LOCAL PLUMBING CODE, THAT CODE.

COMMITTEE COMMENT: Subsection (a) of this section is new language substituted for the first clause of the second sentence of former Art. 56, § 444(a), which allowed, rather than required, a county to adopt a local plumbing code or to enforce the State Plumbing Code.
