that former reference was intended only to encompass the comparable federal injunctions. Under federal law, an order that is granted, without a hearing, to enjoin action is denominated a "temporary restraining order". However, in common usage, a "temporary injunction" would encompass both the Maryland forms of "ex parte" and "interlocutory" injunction.

Also in subsection (c)(1) of this section, the defined term "person" is substituted for the former limited reference to "any citizen of this State", for clarity.

Also in subsection (c)(1) of this section, the former reference to conduct as "continuing" is deleted as unnecessary in light of the reference to "irreparable".

In subsection (c)(2)(i) of this section, the former specific reference to an "association, copartnership, or corporation" is deleted as included in the defined term "person".

## 3-209. DISPOSITION OF MONEY.
