3-304. EXAMINATIONS.

(A) RIGHT TO EXAMINATION.

AN APPLICANT WHO OTHERWISE QUALIFIES FOR A LICENSE IS ENTITLED TO BE EXAMINED AS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION.

- (B) TIME AND PLACE OF EXAMINATION.
- (1) SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE BOARD SHALL GIVE EXAMINATIONS TO APPLICANTS AT THE TIMES AND PLACES THAT THE BOARD DETERMINES.
- (2) THE BOARD SHALL GIVE AN EXAMINATION AT LEAST ONCE A YEAR IN BALTIMORE CITY.
  - (C) NOTICE OF EXAMINATION.

THE BOARD SHALL GIVE EACH QUALIFIED APPLICANT NOTICE OF THE TIME AND PLACE OF EXAMINATION.

- (D) SUBJECTS AND METHOD OF EXAMINATION.
- (1) THE BOARD SHALL DETERMINE THE SUBJECTS, SCOPE, AND FORM OF AND THE PASSING SCORE FOR EXAMINATIONS GIVEN UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.
- (2) THE BOARD SHALL PROVIDE EXAMINATION QUESTIONS THAT TEST THE COMPETENCY AND QUALIFICATIONS OF THE APPLICANT.
  - (E) REVIEW OF EXAMINATION.
- (1) IF AN APPLICANT FAILS AN EXAMINATION GIVEN BY THE BOARD, THE BOARD SHALL GIVE THE APPLICANT NOTICE OF THE RIGHT OF THE APPLICANT TO HAVE THE PAPERS OF THE APPLICANT REGRADED.
- (2) ON WRITTEN REQUEST TO THE BOARD, AN APPLICANT WHO FAILED AN EXAMINATION MAY:
- (I) REVIEW THE EXAMINATION QUESTIONS AND THE ANSWERS GIVEN BY THE APPLICANT; AND
  - (II) HAVE THE EXAMINATION REGRADED.
  - (F) RESCHEDULED EXAMINATION.

IF AN APPLICANT FAILS TO APPEAR FOR A SCHEDULED EXAMINATION, THE BOARD MAY REQUIRE THE APPLICANT TO PAY ANOTHER APPLICATION FEE UNDER § 3-303 OF THIS SUBTITLE BEFORE RESCHEDULING AN EXAMINATION FOR THE APPLICANT.
