3-503. PLUMBING INSPECTORS.

(A) QUALIFICATION.

EACH INDIVIDUAL WHOM THE STATE, A COUNTY, OR A LOCAL GOVERNMENT APPOINTS OR EMPLOYS AS A PLUMBING INSPECTOR SHALL:

(1) EACH YEAR ATTEND A CONTINUING EDUCATION COURSE THAT THE BOARD OR, WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE BOARD, A COUNTY OR LOCAL GOVERNMENT CONDUCTS; AND

(2) MEET MINIMUM STANDARDS THAT ARE:

(I) ADEQUATELY ENSURE THAT THE PLUMBING INSPECTOR IS QUALIFIED TO INSPECT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STATE PLUMBING CODE;

(II) ARE ESTABLISHED:

1. BY THE COUNTY OR LOCAL GOVERNMENT IN CONSULTATION WITH THE BOARD; OR

2. IF THERE IS NO STANDARD ESTABLISHED BY THE COUNTY OR LOCAL GOVERNMENT, BY THE BOARD; AND

~~(III)~~ (III) ARE ADMINISTERED:

1. FOR A COUNTY OR LOCAL GOVERNMENT INSPECTOR, BY THE COUNTY OR LOCAL GOVERNMENT THAT APPOINTS OR EMPLOYS THE INSPECTORS; AND

2. FOR A STATE INSPECTOR, BY THE STATE.

(B) CONFLICT OF INTEREST.

AN INDIVIDUAL MAY NOT HAVE ANY FINANCIAL INTEREST IN ANY PLUMBING BUSINESS WHILE EMPLOYED BY THE STATE, A COUNTY, OR ANY LOCAL GOVERNMENT AS A PLUMBING INSPECTOR.
