## 3-607. PENALTIES.

## (A) \$50 FINE.

- (1) IN THIS SUBSECTION, "OFFICER" INCLUDES A SUPERINTENDENT, MANAGER, AND AGENT OF A CORPORATION REGARDLESS OF WHETHER IT ENGAGES IN THE BUSINESS OF PROVIDING PLUMBING SERVICES.
- (2) A PERSON, INCLUDING AN OFFICER, WHO VIOLATES ANY PROVISION OF THE FOLLOWING SECTIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$50 FOR EACH DAY OR PART OF EACH DAY THAT THE VIOLATION CONTINUES:
- (I) § 3-602 ("EMPLOYMENT OF UNAUTHORIZED INDIVIDUAL FOR PLUMBING WORK");
  - (II) § 3-603 ("SAME -- WILLFUL VIOLATION"); AND
  - (III) § 3-604 ("MISREPRESENTATION").
  - (B) \$100 OR 6 MONTHS.

A PERSON WHO VIOLATES ANY PROVISION OF THE FOLLOWING SECTIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$100 OR IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 6 MONTHS OR BOTH FOR EACH DAY OR PART OF EACH DAY THAT THE VIOLATION CONTINUES:

(1) § 3-601 ("PROVIDING OR ASSISTING IN PROVIDING PLUMBING SERVICES WITHOUT A LICENSE");
