SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

1-101. DEFINITIONS.

(A) IN GENERAL.

IN THIS ARTICLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

COMMITTEE COMMENT: This subsection is new language used as the standard introductory language to a definition section.

(B) CONSUMER MEMBER.

"CONSUMER MEMBER" MEANS A NONPROFESSIONAL MEMBER OF A REGULATORY BOARD WHO IS APPOINTED FROM THE GENERAL PUBLIC.

COMMITTEE COMMENT: This subsection is new language added to provide an express definition of "consumer member".

(C) COUNTY.

"COUNTY" MEANS A COUNTY OF THE STATE AND, UNLESS EXPRESSLY PROVIDED OTHERWISE, BALTIMORE CITY.

COMMITTEE COMMENT: This subsection is new language added to indicate that a reference in this article to "county" includes Baltimore City, unless the reference specifically provides otherwise.

Art. 1, § 14(a) of the Code provides that "county" includes Baltimore City "unless such construction would be unreasonable". However, the word
