- (4) MAY NOT HAVE HAD WITHIN 1 YEAR BEFORE APPOINTMENT A FINANCIAL INTEREST IN OR HAVE RECEIVED COMPENSATION FROM A PERSON REGULATED BY THE STATE BOARD.
 - (E) RESTRICTIONS ON CONSUMER MEMBERS.

WHILE A MEMBER OF THE STATE BOARD, A CONSUMER MEMBER MAY NOT:

- (1) HAVE A FINANCIAL INTEREST IN OR RECEIVE COMPENSATION FROM A PERSON REGULATED BY THE STATE BOARD; OR
 - (2) GRADE AN EXAMINATION GIVEN BY THE STATE BOARD.
 - (F) OATH.

BEFORE TAKING OFFICE, EACH APPOINTEE TO THE STATE BOARD SHALL TAKE THE OATH REQUIRED BY ARTICLE I, § 9 OF THE MARYLAND CONSTITUTION.

- (G) TENURE; VACANCIES.
- (1) THE TERM OF A MEMBER IS 3 YEARS AND BEGINS ON JULY 1.
- (2) THE TERMS OF MEMBERS ARE STAGGERED AS REQUIRED BY THE TERMS PROVIDED FOR MEMBERS OF THE STATE BOARD ON OCTOBER 1, 1988.
- (3) AT THE END OF A TERM, A MEMBER CONTINUES TO SERVE UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.
- (4) A MEMBER WHO IS APPOINTED AFTER A TERM HAS BEGUN SERVES ONLY FOR THE REST OF THE TERM AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.
- (5) A MEMBER MAY NOT BE REAPPOINTED FOR MORE THAN 2 CONSECUTIVE 3-YEAR TERMS.
 - (H) REMOVAL.

THE GOVERNOR MAY REMOVE A MEMBER FOR INCOMPETENCE OR MISCONDUCT.

COMMITTEE COMMENT: Subsections (a) through (c), (f), and (g)(1), (3), and (4) of this section are new language derived from former Art. 56, § 532(a), (b), (e), and the second, third, fifth, and sixth sentences of (c).

Subsections (d) and (e) of this section are new language that repeats the provisions of present Art. 41, 8 8-102 that specify the qualifications for and
