2-402. NOTICE OF CHANGE IN STATUS OF STATE LICENSE.

(A) IN GENERAL.

SUBJECT TO THE LIMITATIONS IN THIS SECTION AND § 2-314 OF THIS TITLE, A MASTER ELECTRICIAN WHO IS LICENSED BY THE STATE BOARD AND WHO ASSIGNS A LOCAL LICENSE TO A PERSON WHO ENGAGES IN THE BUSINESS OF PROVIDING ELECTRICAL SERVICES MAY CHANGE THAT ASSIGNMENT.

(B) APPLICATION.

TO CHANGE AN ASSIGNMENT OF A LOCAL LICENSE, AN APPLICANT SHALL:

(1) SUBMIT TO THE STATE BOARD AN APPLICATION ON THE FORM THAT THE STATE BOARD PROVIDES;

(2) PAY TO THE STATE BOARD A CHANGE OF STATUS FEE OF \$50;

(3) SUBMIT TO THE STATE BOARD PROOF OF THE CHANGE OF STATUS OF THE LOCAL LICENSE; AND

(4) RETURN THE STATE LICENSE TO THE STATE BOARD.

(C) ISSUANCE OF NEW LICENSE.

ON PAYMENT OF THE CHANGE OF STATUS FEE, THE STATE BOARD SHALL ISSUE A NEW LICENSE TO THE APPLICANT.

(D) NOTICE TO LOCAL JURISDICTIONS.

THE STATE BOARD SHALL GIVE EACH LOCAL JURISDICTION NOTICE OF ANY CHANGE IN THE STATUS OF A LOCAL LICENSE OBTAINED BY THE USE OF A STATE LICENSE THAT WILL AFFECT THE STATUS OF THE STATE LICENSE.
