

registered, or certified by the appropriate unit continued under this Act for the duration of the term for which the license, registration, or certification was issued, and may renew that authorization in accordance with the appropriate renewal provisions of this Act. Except as expressly provided to the contrary in this Act, an individual who was originally licensed, registered, or certified under a provision of law that has been deleted by this Act as obsolete, continues to meet the education and experience requirements to the same extent as if that provision had not been deleted.

SECTION 11. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, until July 1, 1989, the Maryland Master Electricians Act does not apply to a county that does not have licensing provisions for master electricians as of the date of this Act.

SECTION 12. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1988.
