- (B) (1) NOTWITHSTANDING SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION, EACH COUNTY BOARD SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS DESIGNED TO MAINTAIN WITHIN THE SCHOOLS UNDER ITS JURISDICTION THE ATMOSPHERE OF ORDER AND DISCIPLINE NECESSARY FOR EFFECTIVE LEARNING.
- (2) THE REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY A COUNTY BOARD UNDER THIS SUBSECTION:
- (I) SHALL PROVIDE FOR COUNSELING $\overline{\text{OR}}$ CONFERENCING: AND
- (II) MAY PERMIT SUSPENSION, EXPULSION, OR OTHER DISCIPLINARY MEASURES THAT ARE DEEMED APPROPRIATE.
