AN ACT concerning

Harford County - biquor-Control-Board Alcoholic Beverages

the purpose of conforming certain stated annual salaries of FOR the chairman and members of the Harford County Liquor Control Board with their current rate of pay; clarifying language; and making technical changes; clarifying that alcoholic beverages caterer's license issued in Harford County may only be used within that county; clarifying certain requirements for certain Class B beer, wine and liquor licensees who provide catering services; authorizing the Harford County Liquor Control Board to issue a certain club and organization beer, wine, and liquor on-sale license to a box lacrosse and indoor soccer ball club under certain circumstances; repealing certain provisions concerning alcoholic beverages licensing and the dispensary system that no longer apply in Harford County; modifying certain meeting requirements of the Liquor Control Board; authorizing the Harford County Liquor Control Board to issue a 7-day Special Class B (Inn) on-sale beer and light wine in Harford County; defining a certain term; and license generally relating to Harford County and alcoholic beverages.
