- (3) A permit issued under this section shall have its expiration date indicated on its face in large letters or numbers.
- (e) (1) A disabled person's parking permit shall be issued in the form of a windshield placard of a size and design as determined by the Administration.
- (2) The placard shall contain the following information:
 - The permit number; (i)
- (ii) The name and signature of the issuing authority;
- (iii) The "Disabled designation Permit" displayed within the international wheelchair Parking symbol;
 - (iv) The date of expiration; and
- other pertinent information (v) Any Administration requires.
- A person to whom a disabled person's parking issued shall display the placard described in this section in:
- (i) A Class A (passenger) vehicle or a Class M (multipurpose) vehicle;
- (ii) A Class E (truck) vehicle with a 3/4 ton or less manufacturer's rated capacity and specially equipped for the transportation of or operation by a handicapped individual; or
- I, or J vehicle (iii) A Class H, equipped for the transportation of handicapped individuals and is used exclusively for the transportation of handicapped or disabled individuals.
- (f) When displayed by the person to whom it is issued, the placard shall be placed inside the vehicle in a position that it can be viewed from the outside through the lower right-hand portion of the windshield. When displayed, the person to whom a placard is issued under this section or under a similar provision of law of any state is accorded the privileges contained in § 13-616(f) of this subtitle.
