SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

{e)-(1)--"Health-care-facility"--means:

(i)--A--hospital,--as-defined-in-S-19-301-of-this title;

(ii)--A-related-institution,--as--defined--in--S 19-301-of-this-title;

(iii)--An--ambulatory--surgical--facility--or center--which--is--any--entity--or--part--thereof--that--operates primarily-for-the--purpose--of--providing--surgical--services--to patients--not--requiring--hospitalization-and-seeks--reimbursement from-third-party-payers-as-an--ambulatory--surgical--facility--or center;

(iv)--An--inpatient--facility--that-is-organized primarily-to-help-in-the-rehabilitation-of-disabled--individuals;
