- (f) (2) [Any] (I) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS PARAGRAPH, ANY Sheriff of Calvert County who, since 1948, has served for three or more terms shall receive a pension when he leaves office in the annual amount of \$150 for each year served. This pension shall be paid not less frequently than once a month.

CHAPTER 673

(House Bill 691)

AN ACT concerning

Commercial Law - First Mortgages and First Deeds of Trust - Binders

FOR the purpose of providing that in cases where a lender or credit grantor requires certain insurance to be obtained by certain borrowers prior to making a loan secured by a first mortgage or a first deed of trust on owner-occupied residential real estate, the lender or credit grantor shall accept a binder issued by an insurer or its agent as evidence of insurance; requiring the binder to include or be accompanied by certain provisions; providing for certain exemptions from the requirement that a binder be accepted as evidence of insurance; requiring that an insurer either issue a policy of insurance within a certain time period after the binder is given or provide the required notice of
