SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Health - General

19-115.

(a) [In this section, "health care service" means any clinically related patient service.] (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(2) "HEALTH CARE SERVICE" MEANS ANY CLINICALLY RELATED PATIENT SERVICE INCLUDING A MEDICAL SERVICE UNDER PARAGRAPH (2) (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION.

(3) "MEDICAL SERVICE" MEANS EITHER---A---MEDICINE, SURGERY,---OBSTETRIC,---PEDIATRIC,---PSYCHIATRIC,---COMPREHENSIVE PHYSICAL-REHABILITATION, OR-COMPREHENSIVE-CARE-PROGRAM, INCLUDING AN-INTERMEDIATE-CARE-OR-EXTENDED-CARE-PROGRAM:

(1) ANY OF THE FOLLOWING CATEGORIES OF HEALTH CARE SERVICES:

1. MEDICINE/SURGERY/GYNECOLOGY/ADDICTIONS;
2. OBSTETRICS;
3. PEDIATRICS;
4. PSYCHIATRY;
5. REHABILITATION;
6. CHRONIC CARE;
7. COMPREHENSIVE CARE;
8. EXTENDED CARE;
9. INTERMEDIATE CARE; OR
10. RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT; OR
