

(5) Every trailer park shall provide such sanitary facilities as are required by the St. Mary's County Health Department, in accordance with duly adopted ordinances.

(6) An electrical outlet supplying at least one hundred ten (110) volts shall be provided for each trailer coach space.]

[136-6.

An adequate supply of pure water for drinking and domestic purposes shall be supplied to meet the requirements of the park. The water supply shall be obtained from the faucets only. No common drinking cups shall be permitted. Each trailer coach space shall be provided with a cold water tap. An adequate supply of hot water shall be provided at all times in the service buildings for all bathing, washing, cleansing and laundry facilities.]

[136-8.

The service building housing the laundry facilities shall be a permanent structure complying with all applicable ordinances and statutes regulating buildings, electrical installations and plumbing and sanitation systems.]

[136-9.

Waste from showers, bathtubs, flush toilets, urinals, lavatories, slop sinks and laundries in service and other buildings within the park shall be discharged into a public sewer system in compliance with applicable ordinances or into a private sewer and disposal plant or septic tank system of such construction and in such manner as will present no health hazard.]

[136-10.

No open fires shall be permitted at any place which would endanger life or property. No fires shall be left unattended at any time.]

136-11.

[No] AN owner or person in charge of [any] A dog, cat or other pet animal [shall] MAY NOT permit it to run at large or commit any nuisance within the limits of [any trailer coach] A MOBILE HOME park.

[136-12.

It shall be unlawful for any person to maintain or use any trailer coach which is occupied for dwelling or sleeping purposes
