CHAPTER 697

(House Bill 870)

AN ACT concerning

Higher Education - Tuition Assistance - Physical and Occupational Therapy

FOR the purpose of establishing tuition assistance awards in physical and occupational therapy for qualified students; requiring certain tuition assistance award recipients to provide certain services to students-with-developmental-and learning-disabilities-in-publicly-funded-programs certain handicapped children for a certain period; authorizing the State Board of Education to adopt certain regulations; waiving certain tuition assistance repayment provisions under certain circumstances; requiring certain tuition assistance award recipients to have certain qualifications; defining certain terms; and generally relating to tuition assistance for certain individuals.

Preamble

WHEREAS, There is a severe shortage of physical and occupational therapists trained to work with <u>handicapped</u> children who have developmental and learning disabilities; and <u>now</u>, therefore,

WEEREAS,-The-need-for-certified--physical--and--occupational therapists--is--expected--to--increase--as--more-states-implement programs-to-provide-services-to-handicapped-infants-and--toddlers under--Public--baw--99-457,--"Education--of--the--Handicapped-Act Amendments-of-1986",-now,-therefore,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

SUBTITLE 16. TUITION ASSISTANCE - EDUCATION OF PHYSICAL AND OCCUPATIONAL THERAPISTS
