ANY PERSON WHO VIOLATES THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION, THE REGULATIONS PROMULGATED UNDER ITS AUTHORITY, OR ANY LAWFUL ORDER OF THE FIRE MARSHAL IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND, UPON CONVICTION, IS SUBJECT TO A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$100 FOR EACH VIOLATION. SUBTITLE 1. REGULATION

5-101. DEFINITIONS.

- (A) IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.
- (B) "GOODS" MEANS FRUITS, BAKERY PRODUCTS, VEGETABLES, FISH, OR OYSTERS.
 - (C) "HAWK" MEANS TO SELL, PEDDLE, VEND, OR OFFER FOR SALE.
- (D) "PERSON" INCLUDES AN ASSOCIATION, FIRM, OR CORPORATION. (1963 Code, sec. 145; 1939, ch. 691; 1941, ch. 302; 1988, ch. .)
- 5-102. LICENSES; REGULATION.
- (A) LICENSE REQUIRED. A PERSON MAY NOT HAWK AT RETAIL, IN OR ON THE STREETS OR HIGHWAYS OF SOMERSET COUNTY, OR MAY NOT GO FROM HOUSE TO HOUSE EITHER-IN-A-VEHICLE-OR-ON-FOOT, ON THE STREETS OR HIGHWAYS OF THE COUNTY, FOR THE PURPOSE OF HAWKING7-AT RETAIL, IN GOODS, WITHOUT HAVING PREVIOUSLY OBTAINED A LICENSE FROM THE CLERK OF THE COURT.
- (B) LICENSE FEE. EACH PERSON SHALL PAY \$300 ANNUALLY, IN ADVANCE, FOR EACH-VEHICHE A LICENSE USED FOR THESE PURPOSES ON THE STREETS OR HIGHWAYS OF THE COUNTY. (1963 Code, sec. 145; 1939, ch. 691; 1941, ch. 302; 1977 Code, sec. 39(a); 1988, ch. .)
