Harford County Economic Development Loan of-1986

FOR the purpose of amending-Chapter-376-of-the-Acts-of-the General-Assembly-of-1986-to-alter-the-purpose-of-the-Harford County-Economic-Development-boan-of-1986-by-permitting-the proceeds-to-be-used-for-the-construction-and-equipping-of-an auxiliary-police-building,-and-for-the-rehabilitation, renovation,-and-repair-of-the-Main-Street-Theatre;-adding certain-entities-as-recipients-of-the-loan;-extending-the time-for-the-recipients-to-present-certain-evidence-to-the Board-of-Public-Works;-and-generally-relating-to-the-Harford County-Economic-Development-boan-of-1986.

SHETION--1:--BE--IT--ENACTED--BY--THE--GENERAL--ASSEMBLY--OF MARYLAND,-That-the-Laws-of-Maryland-read-as-follows:

Chapter-376-of-the-Acts-of-1986

authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the total amount of \$125,000, \$75,000 of the proceeds to be used as a grant to Mayor and City Council of Havre de Grace for the construction and equipping of an Auxiliary Police Training and Community Center building, \$35,000 to the Main Street Theatre, Inc. for the rehabilitation, Bel Air, and renovation, and repair of the Main Street Theatre, Inc. in \$15,000 the Edgewood Multipurpose Youth Center, for the rehabilitation and improvement of the Center; requiring certain easements be granted to the Maryland Historical Trust; and generally providing for the issue and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That:

(1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Harford County †Economic Development† #MPROVEMENT Loan of †986 1988 in the total principal amount of \$125,000. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale, and delivery of State general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and issued, sold, and
