SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the provisions of Article 2B, \$53(j) shall remain effective for a period of 1 year and, at the end of June 30, 1989, and with no further action required by the General Assembly, Article 2B, \$53(j) shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

SECTION -2- $-\frac{4}{2}$. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1988.
