## CHAPTER 712

FOR the purpose of altering-the-expense-allowances-of-the-Sheriff and-the-assistant-sheriffs-of-Prince-George's-County; providing-that-this-Act-does-not-apply-to-the-salary-or compensation-of-the-incumbent-chief-assistant-sheriff-and the-assistant-sheriffs; altering the salary of the chief assistant sheriff and the assistant sheriffs of Prince George's County; including the assistant sheriffs in a certain retirement program available to certain-other-county officials deputy sheriffs; and generally relating to the Sheriff and assistant sheriffs of Prince George's County.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings

- (r) (1) The Sheriff of Prince George's County shall:
  - (i) Receive an annual salary of \$50,000;

(ii) Be provided with an automobile during his term as Sheriff for the use and work of the Sheriff's office, with adequate maintenance and insurance for the automobile to be at the cost of the county; and
