CHAPTER 713

(House Bill 1002)

AN ACT concerning

Prince George's County Board of Education -Increase in Compensation PG 408-88

FOR the purpose of providing for an annual increase in compensation for the Chairman and other elected members of the Prince George's County Board of Education.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article - Education Section 3-803 Annotated Code of Maryland (1985 Replacement Volume and 1987 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Education

3-803.

(a) (1) From and after July 1, [1987] 1988, at the beginning of each member's full term, the Chairman of the County Board is entitled to receive \$12,000 annually as compensation and the other elected members are each entitled to receive \$11,500 \$13,000 annually as compensation.
